- The entire church property is a smoke and alcohol free zone. Any violation of this rule will result in immediate loss of deposit.
- Trash must be taken to dumpster in the back parking lot.
- Sweep and pick up any area that has been used.

Costs:

- Members Cost: \$0
- Fellowship Hall \$100
 - A deposit of \$200 is to be paid 2 weeks prior to your event, after which, your deposit will be returned within 2 weeks assuming that no damage has been made to the property.
- Custodian Cost \$100 (Optional)

- 4. It is my express intent that this Release shall bind the members of my family and spouse, if I am alive, and my heirs, assigns and personal representative, if I am deceased, and shall be deemed as a Release, Waiver, Discharge, and Covenant Not to Sue the above named releasees.
